It has only been a few months since we actually re-entered the prisons and have been able to visit the inmates. Sadly, a few had stopped attending services, yet overall the churches continue strong and have shown growth.

The economy of Mexico is in shambles, but many of the men and women who gave their lives to the Lord in prison are now on the outside faithfully carrying on and preaching the gospel to their own people. We also thank the Lord that although our funds have been substantially diminished due to pandemic situations, we have been able stretch them to provide eight of these brothers and sisters with regular support at a minimum of \$75.00 a month. We thank you for this.

Two New Ambulances for the Prisons

On November 5th, we were contacted by a dear friend, Bro. Dave Johnston, from West Plains, Missouri (South Howell County Ambulance District) asking if we were still interested in obtaining ambulances for the prisons. Knowing the need is great, my heart leaped as he told me about two ambulances that they had just “put out to pasture.” It is a very long story, but we eventually were able to get both of these ambulances for only \$4,000! One is a 2009 model and the other is a 2012. They are both Mercedes Benz, with one having had a new motor and rebuilt transmission recently installed. So, we quickly agreed to purchase them although we didn’t have the money in hand. They graciously gave us time to raise the money. We chose not to publicly express the need because we didn’t want to run the risk of receiving \$20,000 or more for a \$4,000 project. We trust you understand what we mean.

So, after prayer, we explained the need to only five men all of whom pastor churches of 100 or less. We had hoped to raise \$5,500.00 to purchase the ambulances, to pay for tags, taxes, and insurance, and to pay for getting them from Missouri to the border. Each of these men of God agreed to present the need to his congregation. Four of the 5 told me they didn’t even take an offering but just asked their folks to pray about it. Within just a few weeks \$6,201.25 was received! The very first offering was \$1.25 given by Branson, a five-year-old little boy, who with tears in his eyes handed it to his pastor saying that he wanted to help!

Though the total was \$701.25 more than we intended to raise the Lord knew that it would be needed. As Bro. Titus Shuecraft and I were returning to the border with the ambulances, it became evident one of them needed a new alternator. We stopped at a garage and were quoted a price around \$1,200.00 for replacing it. We went to eat lunch and to wait for the work to be completed. When we returned, we were given a bill for \$779.23! The owner told us that after learning what we were doing with the ambulances, they wanted to do what they could to help! The Lord knew that we would need just a little extra and He supplied it in advance!

The Lord is always faithful! We also want to thank you for your faithful prayers and support. As things slowly return to normal, we want to thank you for standing with us in this ministry within Mexico’s prisons. It is only through the Grace of God and His people that we are able to continue.
