We hope this newsletter finds you well and filled with the joy that comes from serving the Lord. We wanted to share a few exciting updates with you and the impact your support is having on the lives of inmates in the Mexican prisons of Reynosa and Santa Adelaida (Matamoros).

Advocating for Better Medical Facilities for Incarcerated Women

Human Rights groups have been fervently lobbying the Mexican government to provide improved medical facilities, particularly for their incarcerated women. The government is responding by establishing women's clinics within their prison facilities. In light of this, we received a unique special request from the warden of the Matamoros prison.

Lic. Maira Aguilar reached out to us with a plea for assistance in procuring a much-needed medical examination table for the female inmates. To our astonishment, within just one hour of sending out a plea for help on Facebook, a donation came through from an unexpected source - the women's clinic in Weslaco, Texas, about 20 miles from us right here in the valley! This donation is a testament to the power of God's provision; of Him providing for our needs even before we ask! It will enhance the medical care provided to the incarcerated women in this prison facility, and we are profoundly grateful for this miracle.



A Few Words of Clarification (Hopefully)

In our last newsletter it appears that we weren't very clear in explaining some changes that will be taking place with the ministry. First, let us say that *WE ARE NOT* leaving the Mission work or the ministry. The work will continue as before, perhaps in some ways better. As mentioned in our last newsletter, the health of our extended families, the great distance from our grandchildren, and our own aging have been considered in this move. In addition, although we are uncomfortable giving full explanations, the special needs of our ten-year-old son have weighed heavily in our relocation decision. The prison officials have embraced him as a representative of our ministry. Javier, through the Lord's blessings, has grown into an exceptional preacher, and his heart is dedicated to prison ministry. Over time, we have entrusted him with more responsibilities, including pulpit ministry and facilitating the studies. His passion and dedication shine brightly, and he is doing an outstanding job.

Land Donation for a New Church in Reynosa

This land is conveniently located near the prison in Reynosa, and while the congregation may be small, many attendees are former inmates.
